

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, G. B. Stannard has presented to the State Engineer
Amended
the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from
Cat Creek
through the Stannard Ditch
for
Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 13, T. 8 N., R. 29 E. unsurveyed, when SE corner said Sec. 13
bears S. 83° 27' E., 2339.3 feet
situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913,
as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915; has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such
appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.3839 cubic feet of water per second.
Period of use, from March 1st to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 7, 1911.

for which acquired.
