CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, DENNIS COYLE has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from BUSTER SPRING

through a cut and pipe line for STOCKWATERING AND DOMESTIC

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: AT A POINT IN THE NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 7, T. 17 N., R. 58 E., which bears N. 52° 19' E., 2455.2' from the SW corner of said Sec. 7.

situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator DENNIS COYLE

Postoffice address Hamilton, White Pine County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 0.0108 of a cubic foot of water per second.

Period of use, from April 1st to June 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation December 13, 1917.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:

Description of works of diversion and use:-

A well 14' deep and a cut 85' long has been made to develop water. Water is diverted from the well and cut by means of a 1 1/2" and 2" pipe line 90' long, and conducted to an iron tank 6' in diameter and 2 1/2' high, where same is conserved for watering stock.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
