CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, LESTER S. COREY, for the VINEYARD/ LAND AND STOCK CO. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

WARM SPRINGS
through the Warm Springs Ditch for
IRRIGATION AND DOMESTIC

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 14, T. 40 N., R. 69 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation Two and fifty-five one hundredths (2.55) cubic feet of water per second.
Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 13, 1912
