CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, JOSEPH OXBORROW has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from OXBORROW SPRINGS through reservoir and ditches for IRRIGATION purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at the reservoir in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 11 N., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator JOSEPH OXBORROW
Postoffice address Lund, White Pine County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 0.2370 of a cubic foot of water per second.
Period of use, from May 1st to October 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 23, 1916.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:

Water from main Spring is conserved in a small reservoir of about 2.3 acre feet capacity, and diverted therefrom by means of ditches to land irrigated.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
