CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Anna Boylan has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Bishop Gulch
through Bishop Ditch for
Irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:
in the NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Sec. 23 T.43 N. R. 30 E. M.D.B. & M.
situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount, of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.3592 of a cubic foot per second
Period of use, from April 1st to September 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 14, 1914.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:
27.70 acres alfalfa and grain in the NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ Sec. 24 T.43N R.30E.
1.22 acres garden " " " " " " "
7.00 acres grain and alfalfa " " NE¹/₄ " " " "
35.92 acres total

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
