CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Henry Anderson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from snow water streams on the north and west sides of Peavine Mountain.

through Anderson Ditch for Irrigation and Domestic purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: head of Anderson Ditch in the NE 1/4 Sec. 21, T 20 N. R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Henry Anderson

Amount of appropriation 0.0078 of a cubic foot of water per second.
Period of use, from April 1st to October 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 12, 1911.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:
0.78 acre Garden in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 1, T 20 N. R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M.

NOTE:- The flood waters of various canyons on the north and west sides of Peavine Mountain are collected by means of the Anderson Ditch and used on the irrigated land herein described.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
