

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John A. Sharp. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Burch Creek
through a ditch for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SW¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Sec. 21, T. 31 N. R. 59 E., M.D.B & M.
situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator John A. Sharp,
Postoffice address Arthur, Elko County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 0.1934 of a cubic foot of water per second.
Period of use, from May 1st to August 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 30th, 1915.
