CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, The Utah Construction Co. has presented to the State Engineer

of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from  
An Unnamed Spring  
through a pipe and troughs for  
stock watering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the SW 1/4 of Sec. 17, T 37 N. R. 66 E., M.D.B. & M., from whence the NW corner, said Sec. 17 bears S. 36° 0' W. 1305 feet.

situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator The Utah Construction Co.,  
Postoffice address P. O. Box 726, Ogden, Utah.  
Amount of appropriation 0.0075 of a cubic foot of water per second.  
Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation August 23rd, 1917.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:  
Description of works of diversion and use:

There are 55' of trenches, 2' wide and 2' deep dug from the spring, at the confluence of which there is a sump 12' in diameter and 2' deep. 20' of 2" pipe conduct the water from the sump to two troughs 2' wide, 1' deep and 16' long.

Water is conserved in these troughs for 200 head of cattle and 50 head of horses.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
