CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. H. Cornell has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Belmont Spring through a ditch for Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at the spring in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 9 N. R. 45 E., M.D.B. & M., from whence the 1/4 corner on the S boundary of said Sec. 26, bears S 30° 37' W., 4299 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator J. H. Cornell,
Postoffice address Belmont, Nye County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 0.058 of a cubic foot of water per second,
Period of use, from April 1st to October 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 15th, 1918.

NOTE: Two small reservoirs in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 9 N. R. 45 E. furnishes a means of conserving the water to assist in the irrigation of the above land.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
