

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, H. L. Butler, assignee of Charles Monahan has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Dry Creek through Butler Ditches Nos. 1 and 2 for Irrigation Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Sec. 16, T 42 N. R. 62 E., M. D. B. & M. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:
