CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Gr. Saldubehere has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Saldubehere Spring through an earthen dam and reservoir for Stock watering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: near the SW corner of the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 34, T 26 N. R. 63 E., M. D. B. & M.

situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Gr. Saldubehere.
Postoffice address Cherry Creek, White Pine County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 0.025 of a cubic foot of water per second
Period of use, from June 1st to October 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 29th, 1918

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:

Description of works of diversion and use:-

An earthen dam about 15' long and 3' high has been constructed across the natural outflow channel of the spring, forming a pond about 20' across and 2' deep, which is used to conserve the water for the purpose of watering approximately 5000 head of sheep

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
