

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Edward Wagner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from a spring known as "Spencer Spring No. 1." through a pipe line for milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the NE NW Sec. 10, T. 5 N. R. 34 E., M. D. B. & M., situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Edward Wagner
Postoffice address Wheeling, W. Va.
Amount of appropriation 0.01 of a cubic foot of water per second
Period of use, from January 1st to January 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 10th, 1916.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:
Description of works of diversion and use:-

Water from the spring runs down near the point of diversion in certificate No. 553, issued under permit No. 4178, and by means of a dam and pipe is diverted into the well described in certificate No. 553 and from there pumped through 1282 feet of 2" pipe to five storage tanks, of a total capacity of 25,000 gallons, located in the NW NW Sec. 10, T. 5 N. R. 34 E., at a point from whence the NE cor. Sec. 3, said township and range bears N. 37° 17' E. 7265 feet. From said tanks it is used for concentrating ore in a mill and for domestic purposes. The elevation of the mill is 210' higher than the well from which the water is pumped.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
