


THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, David F. Evans has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Streib Spring through a reservoir and ditch for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 4, T. 21 N., R. 18 E., H. D. B. & M. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator David F. Evans
Postoffice address Chilcoot, California
Amount of appropriation 0.1 of a cubic foot of water per second.
Period of use, from March 15th to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 26, 1918.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:
10 acres alfalfa and grain in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 4, T. 21 N., R. 18 E., M. D. B. & M.



The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
