CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. E. ROSE has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Trail Canyon Creek through          Ditch          for          Irrigation and Domestic         

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a blazed birch tree 8 inches in diameter from whence the S.E. cor. of Sec. 18, T. 1 S., R. 34 E., M.D.B. & M. bears S. 31° 30' E. a distance of 10,916.0 ft. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation Four tenths (0.4) of a cubic foot per second.  
Period of use, from March 1st to November 1st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation November 2, 1914.

11.7 " NE 1/4 SW 1/4 " " " "

6.4 " SW 1/4 NE 1/4 " " " "  
40.6 " Total

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
