CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Thomas J. McMillan, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from North Fork Salmon River, dam and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**SE part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T.47N., R.62E.,
M.D.B. & M., situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.**


