CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L. S. Corey, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from unnamed springs, dam and reservoir for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 22, T.44N., R.62E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 22 bears S. 70° E., a distance of 1,448 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water from a spring in the east part of the NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 27, T. 44 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., and water from a spring in the south part of the SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 22, T. 44 N., R. 62E., M.D.B.&M., form a confluence at the point of diversion above described where a dam has been constructed thus forming a small reservoir which conserves water for approximately 300 head of cattle and from 2,000 to 3,000 head of sheep.

This certificate corrects the description of the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.



WHEREAS, Vineyard Land & Stock Company, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from unnamed springs through dams and reservoirs for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the SW 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 44 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M., which bears N. 70° W. 1448 feet from the E quarter corner said Sec. 22, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion and use: Water from a spring in the E part of NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 44 N., R. 62 E., and water from a spring in the S part SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 22, form a confluence at the point of diversion above described, where a dam has been constructed, thus forming a small reservoir, which conserves water for approximately 300 head of cattle and from 2,000 to 3,000 head of sheep

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
