

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, N.C. Johnson for appropriators below has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from
Big Spring
through the Big Spring Ditch for
Irrigation
purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the N. part SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. 5, T. 31 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Names of appropriators N.C. Johnson, Geo. A. Becker and Walter Roach.


Postoffice address Winnemucca, Humboldt County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 0.005 of a cubic foot of water per second, or 1.5 acre feet per season.

Period of use, from April 1st to September 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 2nd, 1919.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:
0.5 acre garden in the SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. 5, T. 31 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M.



The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
