**THE STATE OF NEVADA  
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, James Ryan has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cottonwood Spring through pipeline for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 7, T. 5 S., R. 64 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator James Ryan  
Postoffice address Caliente, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation .015 cubic foot per second.  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation September 29, 1919

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is piped approximately 160 feet through 3/4 inch pipe to a cement trough 10 feet long, 5 feet wide, 1 1/2 feet deep. Water is conserved in this manner for 500 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
