CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. W. Griswold has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Baseo Spring No. 1 through reservoir and pipeline for stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 31 N., R. 63 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Griswold-Henderson L. & L. S. Co.
Postoffice address: Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: .0125 cubic foot per second
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 16, 1920

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A small reservoir at the spring stores water which is transported by means of a pipeline 100 feet long and 2 inches in diameter to galvanized iron troughs 12 inches wide and 8 inches deep and 175 feet long. Water is conserved for 2000 sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
