CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Albert C. Aiken has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Rosebud Spring through pipeline and ditch for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 18 S., R. 55 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Oaks Realty Co.
Postoffice address: Pahrump, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation: 0.0015 Cubic foot per second.
Period of use, from June 1 to December 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 20, 1919.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The works consist of cleaning and brushing out the spring.
Water is conducted from the spring through a pipe to a trough and water is conserved in this manner for 150 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
