CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, John H. Conaway has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Narrow Canyon Spring Dam through Narrow Canyon Spring Dam for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 7. S., R. 65 E., M. D. B. & M. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 149, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator John H. Conaway
Postoffice address Caliente, Nevada
Amount of appropriation .003 cubic foot per second
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 28, 1919

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is stored in the canyon by means of a dam, 20 feet long; 6 feet wide and 2 feet deep and is thereby conserved for the watering of 200 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
