CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. H. Sweetland has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Dressler Spring No. 4 through Unnamed ditch for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 13 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: W. F. Dressler
Postoffice address: Gardnerville, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: .025 cubic foot per second
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 1st, 1921

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Nine small reservoirs are constructed below the spring and are connected by a ditch. The total storage capacity of the reservoirs is 10,000 gallons. Water is conserved in this manner for 4000 sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
