

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L.A.C. Yelland has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Taft Creek through unnamed ditch for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 14, T. 17 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B.M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 1996 cubic foot per second or 59.88 acre feet per season.  
Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation May 5, 1915

Description of irrigated lands to which water is appurtenant is as follows:

19.96 acres - total

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
