CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles Bray has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Stable Spring through unnamed ditch for irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 10, T. 20 N., R. 40 E., M. D. B. & M. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Charles Bray
Postoffice address: Austin, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0025 cubic foot per second or 0.75 acre foot per season.
Period of use, from June 1st to October 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 8th, 1923

Description of irrigated lands to which water is appurtenant:
0.25 acre in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 20 N., R. 40 E., M. D. B. & M.
0.25 acre - total

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
