CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS S. P. Hill has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Harris Creek formed by Harris Spring No. 2 through a dam and ditch for

Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SW part of the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 1, T. 20 S., R. 57 E., MDB&M.

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator S.P. Hill

Postoffice address Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0531 of a cubic foot of water per second, or 31.86 acre feet per year.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year, inclusive

Date of priority of appropriation June 3rd, 1919

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
