CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jessey F. Baker has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Gold Creek

through The Baker Ditch for

Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the W. part of Lot 1, Sec. 24, T. 44 N., R. 55 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Jessey F. Baker

Postoffice address Gold Creek, Elko County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.293 of a cubic foot of water per second, or 87.9 acre feet per season.

Period of use, from March 15th to July 15th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 20th, 1918.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:

Table with 10 columns: Area, Land Use, Section, Township, Range, Meridian, etc. Rows include: 3.0 acres grass, 3.0 grain, 2.1 SW 1/4 SW 1/4, 4.4 grass, 7.1 sage & grass, 1.5 meadow in, 0.2 garden, 0.1 SE 1/4 SE 1/4, 1.6 meadow, 1.4 grain, 1.3 grass, 3.6 sage & grass, 29.3 acres - total.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
