CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Henry Riter has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Franktown Creek through the Bowers' Mansion Pipeline for Power

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point about the center of the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 16 N., R. 19 E., MDB&M, which bears S. 77° 07' W. 3316 feet from the NE corner of said Sec. 9. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Henry Riter
Postoffice address Franktown, Washoe County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation Three (3) cubic feet of water per second.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year, including
Date of priority of appropriation January 8th, 1923

Description of works of diversion and use:
There is a concrete dam and intake box, 12 feet long, 4 feet high, and 7 feet tapering to 4 feet in width, at point of diversion. Water thus diverted is conveyed through 1626 feet of 10 inch wood stave pipe to a power house located in the N. part of the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 16 N., R. 19 E., where power is generated for lighting and general power purposes at Bowers' Mansion located in the S. part of the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 16 N., R. 19 E. Water is returned to stream just below the power house.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
