CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER


WHEREAS, Pete Mariluch has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lockett Spring through a pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering

purpose. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the NE 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 18 N., R. 61 E., unsurveyed, which bears S. 27° W. 1007 feet from the E corner on the N. boundary of Sec. 7, T. 18 N., R. 61 E. MOBAN. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, season, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Pete Mariluch
Postoffice address: Schellbourne, White Pine County, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0125 of a cubic foot of water per second.
Period of use, from July 1st to October 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 3rd, 1920

Description of works of diversion and use:
The spring has been cleaned out and a small rock and earth dam has been constructed by means of which water is conducted through a 3" pipe 6 ft. long to a series of five wooden troughs, each 1' x 1' x 10" where it is conserved for watering approximately 2000 head of sheep.



The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
