CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L.A. Friedman, President of the Pacific Smelting and Metals Corporation has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from a Well in unnamed spring "Causten" Spring, through a pipeline and storage tanks for Milling and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NW part of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 29, T.25 N., R.25 E., MDB&M. situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Pacific Smelting and Metals Corporation.
Postoffice address Lovelock, Pershing County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 0.0833 of a cubic foot of water per second.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year, inclusive
Date of priority of appropriation June 9th, 1924.

Description of works of diversion and use:

A well, 4'x6' and 35' deep has been sunk at point named above, from which water is pumped and conveyed through a pipeline about 200 feet in length to a 130,000 gallon tank located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion. At this point the water supply is augmented by that pumped from the well under certificate No. 1082. The combined water from both wells is then conveyed through 7840 feet of 2" and 2 1/2" pipeline to another 130,000 gallon tank in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 25 N., R. 24 E., where it is conserved for use in the concentration of ores in the mill located in said forty acre tract and for general domestic purposes at the camp situated in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 30, T.25 N., R.25 E., MDB&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
