CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James Henrie, Jr., predecessor in interest has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Point of Rocks Spring

through a pipeline and troughs for

stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SE part of the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 30, T. 3 S., R. 63 E., MDB&M.

situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator J. G. Pace

Postoffice address Cedar City, Utah.

Amount of appropriation 0.009 of a cubic foot per second

Period of use, from October 1st to May 1st of each year following

Date of priority of appropriation April 10th, 1916

Description of works of diversion and use: An open cut 20 feet long has been made at the spring and water has been conveyed therefrom through 18 feet of pipe to a concrete trough 2 feet wide, 3 feet deep and 16 feet long and a wooden trough 16 inches wide, 1 foot deep, and 14 feet long, where it is conserved for watering approximately 1500 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
