WHEREAS, A. K. and Ruth Odgers have presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Trough Spring

through troughs for

Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the E. part of the

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 36, T. 28 N., R. 62 E., MDB&M.

situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriators A. K. and Ruth Odgers,

Postoffice address Cherry Creek, White Pine County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 0.021 of a cubic foot of water per second.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year, inclusive.

Date of priority of appropriation February 25, 1924.

Description of works of diversion and use:

Water is diverted from the spring into two wooden troughs, each 18 feet long, 2 feet wide and 1 foot deep, and one steel tank of 2800 gallons capacity. In this manner it is conserved for watering approximately head of sheep and 300 cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
