CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Frank E. Smiley, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Herder Creek through The Smiley Ditch for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the NE part of the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 36 N., R. 60 E., MDB&M. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 29, Chapter 18, Statutes of 1907 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Wilbur H. Smiley

Postoffice address Death, Elko County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 0.853 of a cubic foot of water per second, or 255.9 acre feet per season.

Period of use, from May 1st to August 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 13th, 1910.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
