

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Guiseppe Buralli has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Walker Spring through pipeline for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point approximately in the SE part of the NW 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 15 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B. & M., which bears N. 49° 38' W. 2148 feet from the SE corner Sec. 35, T. 15 N., R. 22 E. M.D.B. & M. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Guiseppe Buralli
Postoffice address Dayton, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0075 of a cubic foot of water per second
Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 8, 1924

Description of works of diversion and use:
The water is diverted from its source, by means of a pipeline 2 inches in diameter by 25 feet long, to a reservoir about 30 feet wide by 40 feet long by 2 1/2 to 3 feet deep, where it is conserved for watering 240 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
