

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Juan Uhart has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed Spring through a pipeline, trough and reservoir for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the E part NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 16 N., R. 21 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Juan Uhart,
 Postoffice address Carson City, Ormsby County, Nevada.
 Amount of appropriation 0.019 of a cubic foot of water per second.
 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year, inclusive.
 Date of priority of appropriation June 19th, 1920.

Description of works of diversion and use:-
Water is diverted from the spring through 50 feet of 2 inch pipe to a trough; thence from said trough through 90 feet of 2 inch pipe and a ditch to a reservoir, 60 feet by 90 feet and 4 feet deep, located in the E. part NW 1/4 SW 1/4 and W part NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 16 N., R. 21 E, where it is conserved for watering approximately 3000 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
