CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Nathaniel Hawkins has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hawkins Spring through the Hawkins pipeline for Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the center part NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 32 N., R. 51 E., MDB&M. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Nathaniel Hawkins.
Postoffice address: Palisade, Eureka County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation: 0.011 of a cubic foot of water per second.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year, inclusive.
Date of priority of appropriation: October 4th, 1924.

Description of works of diversion and use: Spring has been cleaned out to a depth of 3 or 4 feet, a stone house or cellar constructed over it, a pipeline installed to a measuring barrel, and water conveyed by 256 feet of pipe to a 500 gallon tank located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion. From said tank it is piped to the house of the appropriator and there used for culinary and general domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
