CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, A.C. Florio has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

McCullough Spring
through a pipeline and troughs for
Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 23, T. 18 N., R. 53 E., which bears N. 65°18' E., 27800 feet from the SE corner of T. 18 N., R. 52 E., MDB&M.
situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator A.C. Florio

Postoffice address Eureka, Eureka County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.025 of a cubic foot of water per second.

Period of use, from April 1st to December 15th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 11th, 1916.

Description of works of diversion and use:-

The spring has been cleaned out, walled in, and a small reservoir built and covered over, from which a two inch pipeline conveys water to three troughs by means of which water is conserved for stock purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
