CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, The Adams-McGill Co. has presented to the State Engineer

of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Lewis Well

through a pump, pipeline and troughs for

Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the SW 1/4 Sec. 31, T. 6 N., R. 63 E., MDB&M. which bears N. 49° 0' E. 1030 feet from the corner on the south boundary of said Sec. 31.

situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator The Adams-McGill Company,

Postoffice address Ely, White Pine County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 0.015 of a cubic foot of water per second

Period of use, from November 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 14th, 1925.

Description of works of diversion and use:

Lewis Well is 26 feet deep and has a 42" steel casing. Water is diverted therefrom by means of a horse power pump to a catch basin 15'x40'x3' deep and thence into 150 feet of 20" iron troughs where it is conserved for watering approximately 2500 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
