CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George Parker has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Birmingham Slough through the Parker Ditch for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the N. part of the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 29, T. 15 N., R. 26 E., MDB&M. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator George Parker

Postoffice address Wabuska, Lyon County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 0.8782 of a cubic foot of water per second, or 263.46 acre feet per annum.

Period of use, from March 15th to October 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation March 13th, 1916.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:

Table with 7 columns: Area, Land Use, and Section/Quarter. Includes entries like '7.76 acres grass and brush in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 29, T. 15 N., R. 26 E., MDB&M.', '2.40 clear grass', '5.44 alfalfa', etc., totaling 87.82 acres.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
