CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, St. John Laborde for appropriators below has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

South Fork Silver Creek through Ditch No. 2 for

Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the N. part of the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 21 N., R. 44 E., MDB&M.

situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Laborde Bros. and Co.

Postoffice address Austin, Lander County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 0.099 of a cubic foot of water per second, or 29.7 acre feet per season.

Period of use, from April 1st to August 25th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 21st, 1918.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:

- 0.2 acre meadow in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 21 N., R. 44 E., MDB&M.
