**THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, T.H. Chatom for appropriators below has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Currie Wells through a pipeline and troughs for

Stockwatering and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 22,

T. 11 S., R. 45 E., MDR&M., unsurveyed, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes 1913

has determined the date, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: T.H. Chatom and J.J. Vignolo
Postoffice address: Beatty, Nye County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation: 0.0045 of a cubic foot of water per second.
Period of use, from October 1st to May 1st of each year following.
Date of priority of appropriation: July 17th, 1916.

Description of works of diversion and use: -
Water is syphoned from wells by means of about 300' of 1 1/2" pipe to two troughs, each 3'x8' where it is conserved for watering approximately 150 head of cattle. The syphon has check valves so that when troughs are full water will stop running. A house is built over one of the wells and water is piped to the barn and used at all times of the year for watering saddle horses and milch cows and for domestic purposes and raising garden stuff.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
