Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of  
\_\_\_\_\_ 1913 \_\_\_\_\_ has determined the date, source,  
purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriators T.H. Chatom and J.J. Vignolo

Postoffice address Beatty, Nye County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 0.0015 of a cubic foot of water per second.

Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 11th, 1917.

Description of works of diversion and use: - \_\_\_\_\_

Water is diverted from the spring and conveyed through  
30 ft. or 1" pipe to an iron trough 4'x6', where it is conserved  
for watering approximately 35 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed  
the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which  
acquired.
