CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, T.H. Chatom for appropriators below has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Little Willow Spring through a pipeline and trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 11 S., R. 44 E., NDR&M., unsurveyed, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator S. T. H. Chatom and J. J. Vignolo.

Postoffice address Beatty, Nye County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 0.0022 of a cubic foot of water per second

Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 11th, 1917.

Description of works of diversion and use: Water is diverted from the spring and conveyed through 20 ft. of 1" pipe to an iron trough 4'x8', where it is conserved for watering approximately 70 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
