CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bernard Damele has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Basin Spring No. 1 through reservoirs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the N. part of the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 23, T. 23 N., R. 48 E., which bears N. 61°45' W. 2400 feet from the E. corner on the E. boundary said Sec. 23.

situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Bernard Damele
Postoffice address Tonkin, Eureka County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 0.016 of a cubic foot of water per second
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year, inclusive.
Date of priority of appropriation July 26th, 1917.

Description of works of diversion and use:
Dams have been constructed in the spring channel and six reservoirs 10'x10'x2' thus formed, by means of which water is conserved for watering approximately 500 head of cattle. The reservoirs are within the same forty acre tract as the point of diversion, and extend about 650 ft. down the stream channel from said point.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
