

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bernard Damele has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from West Cottonwood Spring through a pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the NW 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 23 N., R. 48 E., which bears N. 48° W. 2508 feet from the SE corner said Sec. 26, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Bernard Damele
Postoffice address Tonkin, Eureka County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 0.003 of a cubic foot of water per second.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year, inclusive
Date of priority of appropriation July 26th, 1917.

Description of works of diversion and use:-
Water is conveyed from spring through a pipeline to a series of troughs 72 feet in length, where it is conserved for watering approximately 100 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
