CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, J. L. Wathen has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Two Hill Canyon Spring through Wathen pipelines and ditch for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the central part of the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 32 N., R. 51 E. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator J. L. Wathen
Postoffice address Palisada, Eureka County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 0.055 of a cubic foot of water per second, or 16.5 acre feet per season.
Period of use, from April 1st to October 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 11th, 1921.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:
3.7 acres grain in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 32 N., R. 51 E., MDB&M.
0.6 acre plowed " " SE 1/4 SW 1/4 " " " " "

0.4 " alfalfa " " SE 1/4 SW 1/4 " " " " "

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
