

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L. E. Van Riper has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hanging Rock Creek through the Van Riper ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NE part of the NE 1/4 Sec. 8, T. 40 N.R. 23 E., MDB&M. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.2413 of a cubic foot of water per second, or 72.39 acre feet per season.
Period of use, from April 1st to August 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 18th, 1921

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:-
13.26 acres meadow in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 40 N.R. 23 E., MDB&M.

24.13 acres-Total

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
