CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, The Adams McGill Co., Inc. has presented to the State Engineer

of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Eureka Well

through a pump, pipeline and troughs for

Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the SW part of the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 16 N.R. 61 E., which bears N 59° W, 13590 feet from the SE cor. Sec. 13, T. 16 N.R. 61 E., MDB&M.

situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913

has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator The Adams McGill Co., Inc.

Postoffice address Ely, White Pine County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 0.0234 of a cubic foot of water per second.

Period of use, from May 1st to October 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 1st, 1922.

Description of works of diversion and use:-

Eureka Well is 4' x 4' x 90' deep, timbered to a depth of 75 feet. Water is diverted therefrom by a horsepower pump and pipeline to 150 feet of 20 inch steel troughs, where it is conserved for watering approximately 2500 head of sheep and 250 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
