CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Eureka Nevada Railway Company has presented to the State Engineer

of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Tyrone Spring

through a pipeline for

Locomotive and Railroad Transportation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: S. 44° 15' W., 3510 ft. from 2 1/2" iron pipe located 6 feet N of Eureka Nevada Railway track and set for 63 mile post from original survey of said Railway measured from Palisade.

situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Eureka Nevada Railway Company

Postoffice address: Palisade, Eureka County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.00155 of a cubic foot of water per second

Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year, inclusive.

Date of priority of appropriation: June 5th, 1923.

Description of works of diversion and use:-

Water has been developed by a tunnel 3.5 feet wide, 5 feet high and 105 feet long and an open cut 4 feet wide and 125 feet long and it is conveyed through approximately 3600 feet of 1 inch iron pipe to a 3000 gallon red-wood tank at Tyrone Station, and there stored for general railroad transportation purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
