CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. C. Florio has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Young Florio Spring through a pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the NW 1/4 Sec. 29, T. 13 N.R. 55 E., unsurveyed, which bears N 72° 56' W, 25796.2 feet from the NW cor. Sec. 6, T. 12 N.R. 56 E., MDB&M.

situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator A. C. Florio
Postoffice address Eureka, Eureka County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 0.025 of a cubic foot of water per second.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year, inclusive.
Date of priority of appropriation September 22nd, 1922.

Description of works of diversion and use:-
A 200 foot tunnel and 300 feet of open cut have been run at the spring and water is conveyed through 300 feet of 2 inch iron pipe to two iron troughs, where it is used to water approximately 10000 head of sheep and 300 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
