

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. C. Florio has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Little Nevada Spring through a pipeline and troughs for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the NW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 16 N.R. 55 E., unsurveyed, which bears N 83° 57' W, 22870 feet from the NW cor. of Sec. 30 T. 16 N.R. 56 E. MDB&M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator A. C. Florio
Postoffice address Eureka Eureka County Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.02 of a cubic foot of water per second
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year, inclusive
Date of priority of appropriation November 27th, 1925

Description of works of diversion and use:-
A tunnel 80' long, 5' wide and 6' high has been run at the spring and water is conveyed through 195' of 2" iron pipe to 50' of half round iron troughs, 2' wide and 1' deep where it is conserved for watering approximately 8000 head of sheep and 300 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
